

**MINUTES FOR THE 7th MANAGING COMMITTEE OF THE
KANCHEEPURAM DISTRICTS MINERAL FOUNDATION TRUST**

The Seventh meeting of the Managing Committee of the Kancheepuram District Mineral Foundation Trust was convened today (20.05.2020) @ 4.00 pm @ Collectorate Kancheepuram.

The Central Government by Act 10 of 2015 had introduced Section 9B to Mines and Minerals (Development And Regulation) Act, 1957 directing the State Governments, by Notification to establish a Trust as Non-profit body to be called District Mineral Foundation in any district affected by Mining operations.

The Government of India, Ministry of Mines in exercise of powers conferred under Section 20 of the MMDR Act 1957, in the national interest directed the State Government to incorporate the "Pradhan Mantri Khanij Kshetra Kalyan Yojana" in the rules framed by them for the District Mineral Foundation Trust and to implement the said schemes.

Accordingly in exercise of the powers conferred under Sub Section (4) of Section 15 of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 the Tamil Nadu District Mineral Foundations rules were notified vide G.O.(MS) No.57, Industries (MMD.1) Department, dated. 19.05.2017 and certain amendments were made to the same vide G.O.(MS) No.90, Industries (MMD1) Department, dated. 27.07.2017.

In pursuance to the said rules coming into force, the Kancheepuram District Mineral Foundation Trust was constituted vide the District Collector Proceedings Rc.No. 615 / Q1 / 2017 dated 20.10.2017. Hence the 7th convention of the District Mineral Foundation Trust combining both the Managing Committee and the Governing Council has been convened.

As on date 14 projects have been sanctioned at a cost of Rs.6,11,73,600/- by the Governing Council. An amount of

Rs.1,12,53,038/- has been released for the implementation of 4 projects. As per G.O. (Ms).No.81, Industries (MMD-1) Department dated.14.08.2018 prior concurrence has to be obtained from Industries Department, Secretariat for implementation of any projects bearing estimate exceeding 1.00 Crore pursuant to the sanction of the Governing Council.

The total accrual of District Mineral Foundation in respect of Kancheepuram district as on date (14.05.2020) is Rs.11,71,38,317/-. Administrative sanction has been accorded for 10 projects for an estimate of Rs.60,67,000/-(An amount of Rs.17,55,000/- has been released for the implementation of 3 projects). The Govt. vide G.O. No.213, Industries (MMD1) Dept., dated.26.12.2019 accorded sanction for 3 projects for an estimate of Rs.5,08,86,000/- (An amount of Rs.94,98,038/- has been released for the implementation of 1 project).

As per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court in W.P.No.1256/2018 etc., an amount of Rs.2,07,84,352/- has to be refunded to the lessees concerned. Office Expenditure amount of 5% DMF is Rs.18,15,855/-. This leaves a balance of **Rs.3,63,17,107/-**. The below mentioned projects have been received for approval and implementation under PMKKKY.

The Govt. Vide G.O. No.213, Industries (MMD1) Dept., dated.26.12.2019 as approved the project for Improvements to the road from Pinayur - Thirumukkoodal road to Thirumukkoodal village road Km 0/0 to 2/544 in Pinayur Panchayat.

There are about 17 Roughstone quarries in operation in the village of Madhur, Sirudhamur, Peranakkavur, Pazhaveri, Pinayur, Padur, Sirumailur and Sithalapakkam villages of Uthiramalur Taluk. Apart from the quarries there are about 25 No's of stone crushing units in the above said villages. All the Roughstone, aggregates and M-Sand produced are being conveyed and transported out of the above said villages either via Thirumukkoodal - Pazhaveri road or via Thirumukkoodal - Salavakkam highway. On an average about 150 heavy commercial vehicles are using this stretch of road for mineral transportation.

The Salavakkam - Thirumukkoodal highway which was the only route for transportation passes through villages causing hindrance to the local public. Hence the Thirumukkoodal - Pazhaveri road was put into use for heavy vehicular movement for the past 3 years. This has led to minimal heavy vehicular traffic in the residential areas, rendering them very less affected by the quarries and related activities.

All the rough stone and blue metal aggregate laden trucks a majority of them being Multi Axle heavy commercial vehicles of gross vehicle weight of about 25 to 31 tones predominantly use this stretch of road Thirumukkoodal - Pazhaveri for transporting blue metal and aggregates.

It has been a perennial problem faced by the public by these lorries. This stretch of road has witnessed numerous fatal accidents in the near past. The reason is the road not being suitable for free movement of

such heavy load borne Multi Axle heavy commercial vehicles. It has always been a demand of the local public to widen the road and lay the same with a quality specification accommodating such heavy loaded vehicles.

As the road by and large is being used by the mineral laden lorries, the formation of Thirumukkoodal to Pazhaveri Road shall be taken up to implement PMKKKY under District Mineral Foundation Trust

Hence strengthening, widening and formation of the Thirumukkoodal - Pazhaveri road will keep the heavy vehicular movement away from the local villages and also enable free material movement.

In this regard, the Project Director, DRDA / Joint Director vide his proposal in Na.Ka.No.20/2018/A9, dated.09.05.2020 had stated as follows :

The materials required for Industrial firms and development works viz, stone, aggregates and M-Sand from Pinayur and Pazhaveri villages are being transported in Heavy commercial vehicles via the residential areas of Thirumukkoodal villages. This has rendered the roads unfit for public use further causing accidents and hindrance to the public.

In order to avoid the hindrances, and based on the recommendations of the Governing Council, Managing Committee of Kancheepuram District Mineral Foundation Trust and orders of the Government, the District Collector has accorded Administrative Sanction for the formation of retaining wall and Tar road in Pinayur - Thirumukkoodal village of Uthiramerur Panchayat Union over an estimate of Rs.291.56 Crores utilising the funds accrued in District Mineral Foundation Trust.

Provision has been made for the formation of 5.5 meter wide road. Formation of the road stretch for the said width of 5.5. meter cannot

accommodate two way heavy vehicle transport. Apart from this, chances of creation of traffic congestions will also arise.

Hence the Executive Engineer Rural Development during her field inspection on 27.04.2020 has instructed to further widen the road by 7.5 mts and build a retaining wall and a culvert.

During field inspection on 28.04.2020, the District Collector has assessed the field level conditions. The Executive Engineer, Rural Development, Kancheepuram has indicated the pavement index and width of the road should be extended from the proposed 5.5 meters to 7.5 meters.

Considering the present fund status and prioritising the projects under High priority and other priority as stipulated under rules 13 (3) and 13(4) of the Tamil Nadu District Mineral Foundation Trust Rules 2013. the below mentioned projects were placed before the Governing Council for Scrutiny.

(i) As the combined Kancheepuram District has been bifurcated into Kancheepuram and Chengalpattu Districts, the Ex-Officio Member i.e., The Revenue Divisional Officer, Maduranthagam shall be replaced by The Revenue Divisional Officer, Sriperumbudur in Kancheepuram District.

(ii) Purchase of Office Purpose Desktop Computer, Printer & Laptop for the use of District Mineral Foundation Trust for a cost not exceeding Rs,1,00,000/-.

(iii) The list of 91 Directly & Indirectly Mine affected villages as on august 2018 have already uploaded in the PMKKKY portal. The list of newly added Directly & Indirectly mine affected villages as listed below shall be uploaded in the PMKKKY Portal for to be considered for future development works.
