

**MINUTES OF THE 1<sup>st</sup> MEETING OF THE MANAGING

The First meeting of the managing committee of the Kancheepuram District Mineral Foundation Trust was convened today (17.04.2018) @ 04.00 pm @ Collectorate Kancheepuram.

It was decided to take up the construction of minor bridge at left lane of Km. 1/500 in Thirumukkudal to Pazhaveri Road.

The Thirumukkoodal Pazhaveri State Highway connects Pazhaveri to the East and Thirumukkudal to the West. This stretch of road is the main arterial

road for public and commercial vehicle movement for the villages and Pazhaveri and Thirumukkodal. There are about 16 stone quarries in Pinayur, Sirudhamur, Sirumayilur, Sithalapakkam, Padur and Peranakkavur in the near vicinity of the said stretch of road as follows:

All the rough stone and blue metal aggregate laden trucks a majority of them being Multi Axle heavy commercial vehicles of gross vehicle weight of about 25 to 31 tonnes predominantly use this stretch of road for transporting blue metal aggregates.

It has been a perennial problem faced by the public by these lorries. This stretch of road has witnessed numerous fatal accidents and an accidental death caused by blue metal laden lorry in the near past. The reason is the road not being suitable for free movement of such heavy load borne Multi Axle heavy commercial vehicles. It has always been a demand of the local public to widen the road and lay the same with a quality specification accommodating such heavy loaded vehicles.

The proposal for relaying the stretch of road has already been taken up under general fund and the work is under progress. As the road by and large is being used by the mineral laden lorries, a proposal of constructing and culvert at Left lane of Km 1/500 in Thirumukkodal to Pazhaveri Road shall be taken up to implement PMKKKY under District Mineral Foundation Trust.

Thus, the managing committee of Kancheepuram District, District Mineral Foundation Trust had unanimously accorded approval to place the above mentioned project before the Governing Council for sanction.


